### Former UTLP (Before Feb 2015)

### New UTLP (launched Feb 2015)

#### Practitioner Level (Level 2)

UNIV 798A	←————→	Completion of formal 1+ credit course
Seven 90-min workshops	←————→	Five TLTC workshops or reading groups (60+ min each)
Mentor a TA or observe 3 professors	↔	Three observations of undergraduate instructors
Mentoring: meet three times	←————→	Mentoring: meet three times
Teaching Project	←————→	Teaching as Research (TAR) Project:
Teaching Portfolio	←————→	Teaching Portfolio

#### \*Note:

The new **Associate Level (Level 1)** requires:

1. Complete one of the following two “Paths”:
  - 1a. “Course Path”: 1-2 credit UMD course + one workshop
  - 1b. “Workshop Path”: Five workshops or reading groups
2. Teaching philosophy statement
3. Observation of an undergraduate instructor

#### \*\*Note:

The new **Scholar Level (Level 3)** requires:

Complete all the components of the Practitioner Level (Level 2), plus participation in a learning community, and formal presentation and approval of a “publication-worthy” Teaching as Research Project.
